

# TARGET FRAMES

PLEASE READ & STUDY

Every effort is made to keep target frames at the rifle and pistol ranges, but at times they may not be available. It is recommended that you take a target frame home with you so that you will always have one.

The best option is to become self sufficient and make your own. The target frame illustrated below can be built with a minimum of time and expense. All that is required is a drill motor, half-inch drill bit, and a tape measure or yard stick. We build them with 1-inch by 2-inch (actual dimension 3/4-inch by 1- 3/4-inch) furring strips available at lumber yards. Cardboard can be stapled, screwed or glued to furring strips. NOTE: Holes are spaced 17-inches ON CENTER, not edge to edge.

PLEASE! Avoid un-necessary bullet damage to target holders! Don't place objects on target holders. Don't place any target in such a manner that will result in bullet damage to target holders.
